You'll gain essential skills, industry-recognised certifications, and access to employment opportunities—all while earning and learning in a culturally safe and supportive environment. These traineeships are proudly funded by the Queensland Government and delivered across multiple Kurbingui locations through the Skilling Queenslanders for Work Initiative.

Certificate I Construction (CPC10120)

A Certificate I in Construction (CPC10120) is an entry-level qualification that prepares participants for a range of support roles in the building and construction industry. While it doesn't qualify you as a tradesperson, it gives you foundational knowledge, practical skills, and safety training that help you take the first step toward a career in construction.
